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## Validation

- Research Question - Do the current OPSO custody risk factors and scales predict institutional behavior and adjustment among OPSP offenders?
- Samples -
  - Initial Classification - Offenders booked into OPSO - July 1, 2012 thru June 30, 2013 who were incarcerated at least 28 days. If an offender was incarcerated on more than one occasion between July 1, 2012 thru June 30, 2013, the data from his/her first incarceration that he/he was incarcerated 28+ days was used for the analyses.
  - Reclassification- Offenders booked into OPSO - July 1, 2012 thru June 30, 2013 who were incarcerated at least 90 days.

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## Process

- Process - Assessed ability of risk factors, custody scales and override factors to predict future institutional misconduct -- i.e., institutional violence, disruptive behavior, and overall adjustment.
- Samples:

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## Validation Goals

- Assess the validity of the custody assessment instruments for the current OPSO offender populations.
- Validation asks, *"Does the classification system continue to generate accurate and reliable assessments of the risks to institutional safety and security posed by the NODO offender populations?"*
- **For whom?**
  - Gender-specific
  - Custody assessment (initial vs. reclassification)
- **Revise System:**
  - Refine current and create new risk factors to potentially improve the predictive power of the custody assessment instruments; and
  - Refine the classification process to address current/desired intake, housing, disciplinary, policies.
